



## Nancy W. Narrie

August 11, 1947 - August 26, 2018

Nancy Maurine Wheeler Narrie, 71, passed away Sunday evening, August 26, 2018, after a 28 year battle with breast cancer, which she fought with courage, strength, and determination, including three recurrences. Nancy is survived by husband of 41 years, Steve, daughters Leanne (Bryan Rambo), Guyton, GA, Lindsay (Ryan Bridges, betrothed), Cumming, GA, sister Susan (Robert Holt), Madison, AL, Uncle Thomas Wheeler, Gadsden, AL, several nieces, several nephews, several cousins, and many in-laws.

Born August 11, 1947 in Gadsden, AL, Nancy attended General Forrest Junior High School and graduated from Emma Sansom High School in 1965. Her first career job was as a legal assistant at Hornsby Law Offices in Gadsden. Nancy attended Jacksonville State University and earned an Associate Degree from Gadsden State Junior College in computer science. Nancy was employed by Mosler Safe Company in Atlanta, starting as a secretary in the parts and service department. During her fourteen year career at Mosler, Nancy rose to the position of Executive Assistant to the Regional Vice President of Sales and Marketing. Nancy and Steve met on a blind date on Friday, February 13, 1976 and married on May 27, 1977. After starting a family, Nancy and Steve joined Westminster Presbyterian Church, Snellville, on Thanksgiving weekend 1984, including baptizing their young daughters, Leanne and Lindsay. Nancy decided, soon thereafter, for family quality of life reasons, to accept a part-time secretary position at Westminster Presbyterian Church which blossomed into a twenty-six year career of mission and ministry to our congregation. Nancy retired in 2014 as Church Administrator, certified at the highest level of the PCUSA APA professional society.

Nancy was a devoted wife, loving and supportive mother, caring sister, and kindhearted friend. She was greatly loved and will be missed by many family and friends for her upbeat personality, sincere laugh, and genuine spirit.

A Memorial Service to honor and celebrate the life of Nancy W. Narrie will be held on Saturday, September 1, 2018 at 11:00 AM at Westminster Presbyterian Church, Snellville, GA 30078.
